

# FACE Children's Center Celebrating 50 years



Some Facts about FACE Children's Center, which is Celebrating **50 years** of child care service to the Metrowest Community this year.

FACE is an acronym that stands for  $\underline{F}$ isk  $\underline{A}$ rea  $\underline{C}$ ommunity  $\underline{E}$ ndeavor.

Our Mission Statement:

The mission of FACE Children's Center is to enhance and support children and their families by providing a wholesome and safe day care setting, which offers a nurturing and stimulating environment. All parents can be assured that this educational program constantly strives for excellence, maintains high standards of care, and employs a committed staff.

We have 3 names for our classes:

The TEDDY BEAR classroom is for children starting at age 2 years and 9 months.

The CHIPMUNK classroom is our middle group, children are 3 years 5 months and older.

The BUTTERFLIES are children 4 1/2 years old, who will soon be "flying off" to Kindergarten.

We are fortunate to have a dedicated and professional group of teachers at FACE, who also enjoy a sense of fun being with young children. Have you ever been in the building to hear laughter that erupts from time-to-time?

FACE is open year round Monday through Friday from 7 AM to 6 PM.

FACE is one of the few daycare centers that offer breakfast, a hot lunch, and snacks. We receive some government funding for the delicious home cooked meals provided by our cook.

Children have outdoor playtime twice a day, weather permitting. We use the playground and the side driveway for bike riding and chalk drawing. The backfield is great for soccer and sledding. The Maple tree is a favorite hangout spot for imaginative play. If you are at the church take a walk to the gardens near the shed, the hollyhocks are in bloom now and you'll also find the outdoor classroom, one of our teachers created this spring. Our full time enrollment was 60 children per day before the COVID pandemic and we will return to that number in the fall.

Jane Therriault is FACE's Executive Director. She started her involvement with FACE as a volunteer 47 years ago and has been the Director since February, 1987. We are so fortunate to have had Jane making sure FACE Children's Center runs smoothly for the past 34 years. She recently shared with the FACE Board of Directors that she has felt happy every day that she comes to the center and feels proud to have helped so many families with childcare and so many teachers with careers. FACE Children's Center is a mission outreach of Fisk Church, but next month I will tell you about all of the service projects the children at FACE have participated in.

We hope that you will join us for the 50<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration of FACE after church on October 17<sup>th</sup>.
