We will begin a study of Romans.



<u>Haiti</u> UMCOR is in communication with partners in Haiti and working closely with them to support emergency relief and early response efforts.

UMCOR has awarded a grant to the Methodist Church of Haiti (Eglise Methodiste d'Haiti).
